BACK TO MEMORY LANE

A brief historical re-view of how a loving, kind, Holy and righteous Father, in *Genesis 1:26*, said.

"Let us make man in our image, according to our likeness, let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth" and in Gen. 2:7, it was so, Man was made perfect and Sinless.

THE FALL OF MAN

Brethren, the fall of man in *Gen. 3:1–6*, was not by accident, but a calculated plan by man to undermined or disobey the commandments of God, so that he will be like God, and not die and Sinned. IS IT – PERSECUTION: To be abused, mocked, ridiculed, shamed, mistreated by fellow Brethren, ignored, neglected, harassed, attacked, or injured.

IS IT - FAMINE - To have no food, or to be starved.

IS IT – NAKEDNESS – To be stripped of cloths and earthly comforts.

IS IT – PERIL – To be exposed to risk, to be confronted with danger.

IS IT – SWORD – To be killed, to suffer martyrdom.
