In our text, the disciples and Jesus were crossing the sea of Galilee when a storm began to rage. The disciples were frightened, fearful and faithless in the midst of what they perceived to be a deadly situation and Christ was asleep and the disciples cried to Him to saved them less they perish. In verse 26 *Christ replied, you of little faith, why are you so afraid? Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves and it was completely calm.* 

storm is a period of a very bad weather when there is a lot of rain, snow or strong wind and often lightening- Longman dictionary. Merriam Webster put it as a disturbed or agitated state. In the midst of every devastating storm, there is a space of about 20 diameters where there is calm called the "eye of the storm. Eye of the storm is a place of calm in the centre of the storm. It is a region of calm weather right in the middle of storm.

To be in the eye of the storm, is to be at the centre or deeply involved in an especially difficult, stressful or hectic situation over a period of time. It is a site of serenity (state of being calm, peaceful and untroubled) and tranquillity.
