PARENTAL CARE AND GUIDANCE

Hebrew 12:5–7 Nene, Godwin (Deacon)

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Introduction: Some many years ago everyone wanted to be a parents, but today many are afraid of having children.

In those days, children were really respecting their parents and anybody that's older than them, today reverse is the case, parents have to respect their children.

<u>Definition</u>: A parents is a father or mother who gave birth to a child either biological, nurtures, adoption or raises; a relative can also plays the role of a parents.

Anyone who plays the role of guardian can also be referred to as a parent. And the major role of such individuals is to be parenting by providing care and guardian for children.

As a parents it's important to note that you have a very big responsibilities to play in bringing up our children/wards. Those responsibilities include the provision of basic needs like shelter, food, discipline, clothing, education, nurturing etc. But along the lines

some parents especially fathers do the mistake of living such responsibilities for their children and their mother which might leads to future disaster for both the parents and children, because they care for themselves and this will also put the entire community and the family in dangers of social vices and it's only very few percentage of such children will have the fear of God, while the larger percentage of them will fall into one of the below categories:

- Disrespectful children
- Drug addict
- Arm robbery
- Fraudsters
- Street fighters
- Rapist

Let's see some of the reasons while some parents are not taking responsibilities:

- You can't give what you don't have
- Maybe such parents struggle to survive
- Parents afraid of today's cultural stigma against discipline

- Parents can't bear to cause any pain. There are other ways to get through to a child.
- It's enough simply try to reason with a child. Therefore, there's no need for physical discipline. Give a child time, sooner or later he/she will come around and respond positively.
- Children are basically good and will grow out of their state of rebellion. Just give them time.
- Discipline is barbaric and crude of dark age thinking.
- My wife and I don't agree on how to discipline, so we don't. I trust hope things will turn out okay.
- I don't know how to discipline. I am afraid, I will do it wrong and damage my little one's mental state. Confrontation is not my thing, I will let my wife and the teacher at school deal with my kids' behavioural issues.
- I am not sure I agree with or understand what the Bible says about this matter of discipline.
- I am too busy to bother with the children. I will let my wife deal with discipline issues. She can do it better.

Your need to train your child(ren) so as to see obedience as a key element of who they are as your child and a child of God. And this is the hard part. You as a parents are commanded by God to discipline and correct your children so that they can learn obedience. Although there a lot of child abuse in the name of discipline, I am not talking about such discipline

where parents will robbed their children with hot pepper, tied their hands with rope and leave under the sun, such actions can leads to serious health issues and the rest. But if you listen to the words of God properly and walking by His spirit, you will apply discipline in a proper and loving manner.

Here's more of what God's word has to say:

- *Proverbs* 13:24 He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.
- Proverbs 19:18 Chasten thy son while there is hope, and let not thy soul spare for his crying.
- **Proverbs 22:15** Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.
- Proverbs 23:13-14: Withhold not correction from the child: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die. Thou shalt beat him with the rod, and shalt deliver his soul
- Proverbs 29:17 Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul.

If you refused to discharge your responsibility as a parents, the repercussions are enormous and demoralising:

 Such children will not care for their parents at old age

- Such children will not have respect for their parents.
- Those are the type of children who looks at their parents as liability.
